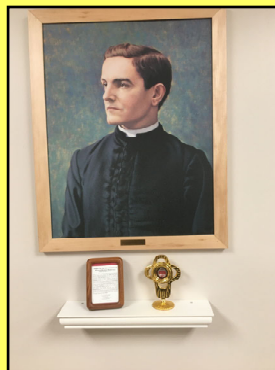

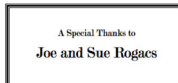

Religious Education News (CCD)

CCD Begins In September! Register your children today! All registrations should be completed online on the Our Lady of Victory Religious Education Website: <https://re.ourladyofvictory.com/home>. **Register your child BEFORE Sept. 3rd for FREE! A fee of \$50/child will be collected from those who register after Sept. 3rd.** This money will help cover the cost of obtaining materials at the last minute for late registrants. **All students need to register, whether CCD, homeschooled or SJCA.**

All Confirmation Track students in grades 9, 10 & 11 must register for CCD regardless of where they receive their religious instruction: public, private or homeschool. Students who attend St. Joseph's Catholic Academy do not attend regular Sunday classes, but are welcome to attend if they wish. They still need to register. The program needs to track ongoing requirements for ALL students. Registering them allows us to do that. You can view these requirements on the religious education website listed above under the HS Religious Education/Confirmation section.
