Songs of Faith II Sunday August 27, 3:30pm in OLV Catholic Church Free open to the public, and live streamed on Facebook Live

Mark L. Lusk, Professor of Trombone at Penn State for the last 37 years, will be presenting a very special and meaningful concert along with pianist, Kathy Gattuso Cinatl and guitarist/trombonist Paul Leskowicz. This ensemble will be joined by special guests; organist Freda Crummey, keyboardist Beth Smith, trombonist/bassist James Gates, and vocalists Mary Leskowicz and Kaitlyn Lusk. The program will feature beautiful and inspirational songs of Faith and Praise. The performance will feature music from across a wide musical span; from traditional hymns, to classic anthems, to contemporary songs.

The concert will be presented on Sunday, August 27, at 3:30pm at Our Lady Of Victory Catholic Church in State College, where Professor Lusk and his family have been members of the parish since 1986.

The Silver Rose, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, will be available to view after all Masses this weekend (August 26 & 27). The Silver Rose is on a pilgrimage around the US, Canada and Mexico in support of the Sanctity and Dignity of all Human life. The program began in 1960. "The Silver Rose was actually a dedication to St. Juan Diego and his meeting with Our Lady and the Miracle of the Roses, when he went back to the bishop and was told to tell him to build a church on the site," said Robert Julian, the Knights' state rose chairman.

The governor was skeptical and told him to bring a sign, Julian said. The Blessed Mother told him to go to the top of the mountain and pick roses that were out of season. "He put the roses in his tunic and dropped it by the governor and Our Lady's image was emblazoned on his cloak and is still visible today." 

CCD Begins September 10! Register your children today! All registrations should be completed online on the Our Lady of Victory Religious Education Website: <https://re.ourladyofvictory.com/home>. **Register your child BEFORE Sept. 3rd for FREE! A fee of \$50/child will be collected from those who register after Sept. 3rd.** This money will help cover the cost of obtaining materials at the last minute for late registrants. **All students need to register, whether CCD, homeschooled or SJCA.**

11th Grade Confirmation Class begins on Sunday, September 10. We will meet in the Church at 1:15pm. It is required that ALL 11th Graders (including St. Joseph Catholic Academy and homeschooled) and at least one parent attend this first session.
