Collection For Haiti (September 18/19) - In a matter of 72 hours (August 14-16), the Caribbean country of Haiti was struck by a 7.1 magnitude earthquake that destroyed countless homes, churches, schools, medical centers and then flooding by Tropical Storm Grace impeded rescue efforts. Haiti is one of the poorest countries in the Americas, with corruption, political instability, poor infrastructure, lack of health care, and lack of education. In good times, the average family lives on less than \$2 per day. The people and the country of Haiti have not recovered from the last major earthquake in 2010. The need is so great at this time.

On the weekend of September 18/19, we will be asking for donations for Haiti. Donation envelopes will be available in the Gathering Space.
