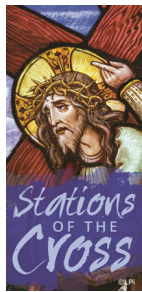
### **Ash Wednesday is February 22.**

#### **Masses:**

**8:00am, 10:00am and 6:30pm**

**Noon:** Scripture service with distribution of Ashes only.

**Fasting and Abstinence:** This Wednesday, Feb. 22, is Ash Wednesday when the Church begins the forty day journey toward the Triduum with the annual discipline of fasting, praying and giving alms. Ash Wednesday (Feb. 22) and Good Friday (April 7) are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent (Feb. 24, March 3, 10, 17, 24, 31) are days of abstinence. **FASTING** refers to only one full meal, with two small meals and no eating otherwise for the day. **ABSTINENCE** refers to not eating meat at all during the day. All who have reached their 14th year are obliged to **ABSTAIN**. The Church directs the holy **FAST** to all those in their 18th year until their 60th year (Canon 1252). The ancient practice of fasting and abstaining can occur throughout other days in Lent. This is not obligatory and can take a variety of forms distinct from food.

#### **Special Lenten Presentation:**

**Friday, February 24.** Following Stations of the Cross, Dr. Pete Roy will talk about the crucifixion from a medical perspective to help deepen our faith about the depth of Christ's Passion on the Cross.

**- Each hour you spend with Jesus will deepen His Divine Peace in your heart.** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on **Tuesdays**, 8:30am and ends with Reposition at

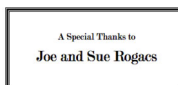
