Society of St. Vincent de Paul November 2020 Report-

In November, SVdP OLV Conference received 38 calls and directly assisted 69 individuals, including 44 adults and 25 children. We helped 12 households secure or maintain housing, provided utility payments for 4 households, and transportation assistance for 5 more. Two people received assistance with medical or dental expenses, and help was given to two prison releasees. Three virtual home visits were conducted. Despite the present challenges, The Society of St. Vincent de Paul continues to assist Centre County residents with basic needs on a case-by-case basis.
