YEAR END CHARITABLE DONATION AND THE 2020 CARES ACT. We thank all those parishioners who have faithfully supported the Our Lady of Victory Parish and School during these hard times. As you are considering your year end financial planning, e.g. taxes, please consider helping with the added expenses and short fall we have experienced.

- If you do not itemize your deductions, you can take a charitable deduction of up to \$300 in cash gifts made to charitable organizations, in the year 2020.

- If you itemize your deductions, the new law allows for cash contributions to qualified charities to be deducted up to 100% of your adjusted gross income for the 2020 calendar year.

- The cap on how much corporations may deduct for charitable gifts increases from 10% of taxable income to 25% in 2020, under the new law. Charitable deductions from corporations in excess of 25% may be deducted for up to 5 years under the usual limits.

- If you are 70 ½ or older, consider making a gift from your IRA or name a Catholic school/parish as a beneficiary. These gifts are transferred directly from your IRA, which can reduce your adjusted gross income. The qualified charitable distribution (QCD) is a great "tax-free" gift – one you can benefit from even if you don't itemize.

Please consult your tax advisor before using these new guidelines with your 2020 contributions to Our Lady of Victory Parish.
