Additional Information:

Each year the parish gives money directly to OLV School from our collection as a subsidy. The diocese provides guidelines. This keeps tuition down and saves school families money.

School Subsidy: \$368,820

This subsidy saved our school families about \$1400 per pupil.

Diocesan Bills:

Each year we pay the Diocese money to help with its operating costs.

Diocesan Assessments: \$464,793

Note: \$181,000 was carry over from previous year

Here are some changes we have made to the budget for next year:

- We have given all school/church employees a "market adjustment" increase to combat inflation. We have devised a formula to address this issue and have compensated employees appropriately.
- We are no longer charging any fee for CCD
