Sixteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Abraham offers a generous welcome to three mysterious men. Saint Paul uses the term "stewardship" to describe the particular mission that has been entrusted to him. Jesus told Martha she was anxious and worried about too many things, "There is need of only one thing." A Christian steward takes time to listen as Mary did, giving Him the first priority of our time no matter how busy we think we are.

Christ calls each of us to be stewards of our personal vocation, which we receive from God. The challenge, then, is to understand that role and to respond generously. But be prepared, like Paul, to anticipate a share of suffering as part of the privilege of being called His stewards.
