16th Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 18): The theme of "shepherds" and "shepherding" flows through all our readings. It is the Gospel that summarizes best what the Lord did for us, and what He continues to do for us. The disciples have just returned from mission work in several communities and villages. They are tired and Jesus recognized that His disciples needed to rest and recover. However, when He saw the crowds He was "moved with pity for them," and His compassion outweighed everything else because they were truly "sheep without a shepherd."

If we are dedicated to being a disciple of Jesus Christ, and live our lives as good stewards, there are going to be times when we, too, are weary, and may feel like we can do no more. Like the Lord, we must learn to gather our strength through Him, to place our trust in Him, and to take the next steps in our faith journeys by doing more, by responding to the needs we see around us.
