Eighteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Saint Paul reminds us how to make decisions so that we can make the best use of the gifts we have been given, "think of what is above, not of what is on earth." Too many people in our materialistic world set priorities that are focused on wealth, status and power. How foolish and naive! Jesus makes it clear that life is not about "stuff," "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions."

Don't be ashamed of living differently from the people around you. Be confident as you set priorities based on what is above. Christian stewards are wise in God's eyes. You will be rich in what matters most. What matters most to you? (*Stewardship Reflection*, Catholic Stewardship Consultants, Inc. 2019/8/02)

Who and What's a Deacon? A Deacon is an ordained minister of the Catholic Church. There are three groups or Orders of ordained ministers in the Church: Bishops, Priests and Deacons. Deacons are ordained as a sacramental sign to the Church and to the world of Christ, who came "to serve and not to be served." The entire Church is called by Christ to serve, and the Deacon, in virtue of his sacramental ordination and through his various ministries, is to be a servant in a servant-Church.

What are these "various ministries" of the Deacon? All ordained ministers in the Church are called to functions of Word, Altar and Charity.

- As ministers of Word, deacons: proclaim the Gospel, preach homilies, and teach in the name of the Church. Deacons also provide spiritual direction and counsel.

- As ministers of Altar: deacon may baptize; witness marriages; serve as ordinary ministers of the Eucharist; assist at Mass; lead the faithful in prayer and Eucharistic devotions; assist with Christian burial by conducting vigils and committals.

- As ministers of Charity, deacons are leaders in identifying the needs of others, then marshalling the Church's resources to meet those needs.

The extent that the Deacon does these various things depends of course on their schedule and availability. It is important to note that these roles and ministries of the Deacon are the norm, not the exception. In other words, these are not things the Deacon does "if the Priest is not available," etc., but rather, things that he can and normally should do by virtue of his office.
