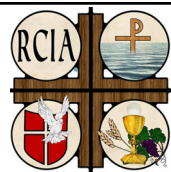

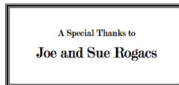

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Would you like to bring the fullness of our Catholic faith to young people in your life in a way that will draw them in and hold their attention? Do you want them to be asking for more lessons? Look no further than **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd**. Meredith Yonushonis, a fully trained CGS catechist has been working hard to get Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, a hands-on catechetical program developed by Dr. Sofia Cavalletti, a Catholic Biblical scholar, and Gianna Gobbi in Rome in 1954 off the ground at OLV in State College, PA. Since this program began 69 years ago, it has spread throughout the world. It is now used in homes, parishes, and schools worldwide. While the delivery method is Montessori based, learning through play, the content (not developed by Maria Montessori, but by Sofia and Gianna) is solidly Catholic. Meredith and two other Level I trained CGS catechists did a great job teaching OLV parish preschool age children about our faith utilizing CGS this past year.
