FROM THE PASTOR.....MY DEAR PARISH FAMILY, a week or two ago, Fr. Jonathan and I received the **HOLY WEEK DIRECTIVES** from the diocese. I am sure they were up on Proclaim and you probably have noticed that there are some slight changes from the “normal way” of celebrating the various liturgies.

- Palm Sunday – palms will now be given out at the end of Mass, handed to you by the ushers only. There will be no outside procession and the only processions will be by the priests and deacon.
- Holy Thursday Liturgy celebrated at 7:00 PM – there will be no foot washing and procession only by priests and deacon. We will have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 10:00 PM.
- Good Friday Service celebrated at 1:00 PM – there will be no kissing or touching of the cross for veneration. Just a bow or genuflection before the cross is now the proper sign of reverence.
- Easter Vigil – no blessed fire outside or inside nor candles for the people to hold. We will still have the Rites of Initiation for those coming into full communion with the Catholic Church. The Easter Vigil Mass will be celebrated at **4:00 PM FOLLOWED BY AN EASTER MASS AT 6:30 PM SO THAT WE MIGHT BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE THOSE WANTING TO COME TO MASS FOR EASTER.**

Once again, the above are just a few of the major changes given to us by the diocese. I am sure that given the present circumstances, we can all adjust for this year. And hopefully, this will be the last year we have to worry about this.

And on a similar note, the **EASTER DAY SCHEDULE** of Masses is 7:30, 9:30, and **11:30 AM. Please make special note that the last Mass is at 11:30 and not Noon. And from here on out, the 11:30 Mass will be the normal last Mass on Sunday at OLV. We are moving the time ½ hour earlier. This change will begin on Easter Sunday and continue on till further notice.**

Just another reminder that our **PENANCE SERVICE** will be held on Palm Sunday at 2:00 PM. We will have the assistance of extra priests and it will be conducted like our Advent Penance Service – the priests will be sitting around the church, come in, go to a priest, and then you are free to leave. There will not be a service as such beforehand. This will help with the needed spacing and time spent in church according to the guidelines.

As of this typing, the only extra **PENANCE SERVICES** in the Northern Deanery are scheduled for Monday, March 22 at 7:00 PM at St. Matthew's in Tyrone and Tuesday, March 30 at Penn State. We have not received any other notice about penance services being held in other churches. So Tyrone would be another opportunity to celebrate the sacrament for the Easter Season.

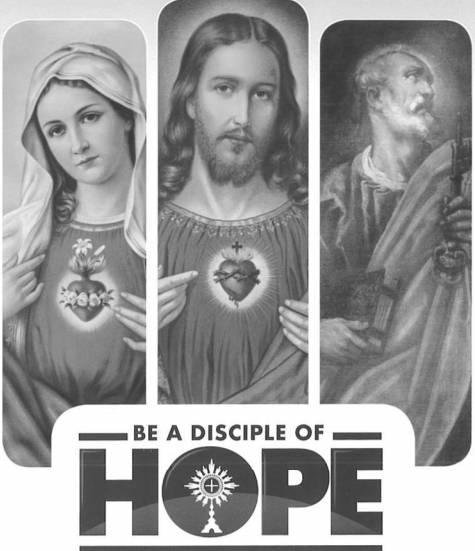
