**Fasting and Abstinence:** This Wednesday, March 5 is Ash Wednesday when the Church begins the forty day journey toward the Triduum with the annual discipline of fasting, praying and giving alms. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (April 18) are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent (March 7, 14, 21, 28, April 4, 11 & 18) are days of abstinence. FASTING refers to only one full meal, with two small meals and no eating otherwise for the day and applies to those 18 to 59. ABSTINENCE refers to not eating meat at all during the day and applies to those 14 and older. The ancient practice of fasting and abstaining can occur throughout other days in Lent. This is not obligatory and can take a variety of forms distinct from food.

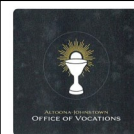
