The month of May begins the series of reflections on Pope Francis Apostolic Letter, *Patris Corde* (With A Father's Heart) released on December 8, 2020.

WITH A FATHER'S HEART: that is how Joseph loved Jesus, whom all four Gospels refer to as "the son of Joseph". [1] Matthew and Luke, the two evangelists who speak most of Joseph, tell us very little, yet enough for us to appreciate what sort of father he was, and the mission entrusted to him by God's providence. [2]

Saint Joseph, Model of Workers, pray for us.

Pope Pius XII proposed Saint Joseph as Patron of Workers. [3] Each year the Catholic Church celebrates the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1. We know that Joseph was a carpenter (Mt 13:55) who was always ready to carry out God's will. In his Apostolic Letter, *Patris Corde*, Pope Francis states, "there is a renewed need to appreciate the importance of dignified work, of which Saint Joseph is an exemplary model." *Patris Corde*, December 8, 2020, 1. 2. 2021, Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown Liturgy Committee, Liturgy Office, Mary, Mother of the Church Pastoral Center, 2713 W.
