Saint Joseph Patris Corde, 7. A Father in the Shadows

The Polish writer Jan Dobraczynski, in his book *The Shadow of the Father*, tells the story of Saint Joseph's life in the form of a novel. He uses the evocative image of a shadow to define Joseph. In his earthly relationship to Jesus, Joseph was the earthly shadow of the heavenly father: he watched over him and protected him, never leaving him to go his own way. Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person.

Pope John XXIII was nicknamed the Pope of St. Joseph as he always made public his devotion to St. Joseph. He described St. Joseph in this way to a large group of seminary rectors in 1961, "Meek, quiet, discreet: St. Joseph is the perfect model for imitation in circumstances that recur in every age and that call for self-denial and total abandonment to God." St. Joseph was named Patron of the Second Vatican Council so that "the Council may be tranquilly prepared for and well-conducted, thus bringing abundant fruit to souls."
