With extended hand I would like to invite you all for a spaghetti dinner sponsored by the Knights of Columbus benefitting the Catholic Primary School of Mylapuram, located in the state of Tamil Nadu, southern India, and holds a very special place in my heart. This is the school which my parents, my siblings and I all attended in my hometown in India.

Some information about the school . . . the name of the school is the "Roman Catholic Primary School." It has a staff of six with 160 students. The school is for kindergarten to fifth grade. It has a long history. The school has been in use for nearly 100 years. In the beginning it was just built with mud and coconut leaves. Later it was cement and bricks. The present building is concrete. It is now in need of a new building, because of damage done over 30 years by heavy monsoon rains. The building had undergone several repairs but is now in need of new construction.

All the students of the school are from poor backgrounds. The expected total cost of the new building is \$70,000. We have already gathered \$53,000 to date. Your generous contributions and donations can help us reach our goal and change the school building which would provide the best education and safe environment for the student and teachers.

A special thanks to Fr. George, the Knights of Columbus, Catholic Daughters, all the volunteers and parishioners for supporting this very important project. Please plan to come and join us for fellowship and a delicious meal!

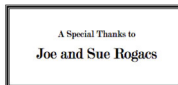

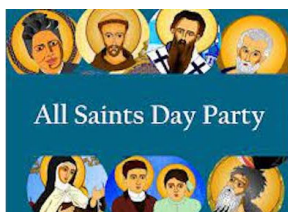


Children's Holy Hour, Tuesdays 10:30am to 11:30am during Adoration.
