Sunday, October 13 at 3:30pm Songs of Faith III, featuring Mark L. Lusk

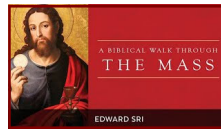

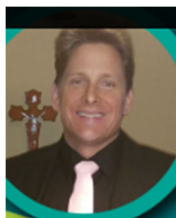
