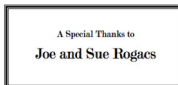

My Insight to the development of "Children Drawn To Our Mother Mary" Oil painting by Beverly Klucher:

Three years ago I was captivated by the new installation of Our Blessed Mother Mary statue at the main entrance of Our Lady of Victory. The masterfully sculpted detail; hands holding the Christ child and face of Our Lady personify the tenderness, love and caring of Mary to whom we express our devotion. The moment dwelled within me for some time.

Three months ago, thoughts of this lovely image resurfaced and my mind began to fill with renewed devotion to Our Lady. I sensed something else happening. I began to envision ideas and pictures on paper with the statue as a major focus. Numerous times in the past, I would be inspired similarly with an experience such as this where my faith would kick in and push me to create a painting. But this time I knew those most important gifts in our lives, our children had to be a part of this religious piece. An endeavor easier said than done.

Photos of the statue shadowed by afternoon sunlight was the visual I needed to create a focal point for the formation and placement of various figures, some imagined and some real. With my intent and experience of three years past uppermost in mind, the religious painting emerged slowly.

Five weeks later, early August the painting was near completion. I say that because invariably something needs to be changed or added (in this instance our little dog who had passed). The day before Our Blessed Mother's Assumption, August 14, I signed the painting.

My hope is that my experience has come to light. Could this bring to our children a special feeling of tenderness toward others and devotion to Mary and baby Jesus in a special way?
