**Saint Joseph Patris Corde,
4. An Accepting Father, Joseph Most Brave.**

Imagine how perplexed Joseph must have been dealing with the mystifying events taking his place in his and Mary's life. In *Patris corde*, Pope Francis explains that, "Often in life, things happen whose meaning we do not understand. Our first reaction is frequently one of disappointment and rebellion. Joseph set aside his own ideas in order to accept the course of events and, mysterious as they seemed, to embrace them, take responsibility for them and make them a part of his own history." As Joseph did, are we willing to accept with faith, the challenges that face us?

We are reminded every time we celebrate Holy Eucharist that St. Joseph had indeed accepted his role in history. In 1962, Saint John XXII, Pope, inserted St. Joseph's name in Eucharistic Prayer I. Pope Francis, then decreed on May 1, 2013, in *Paterna vices* (Fatherly care) that the inclusion of St. Joseph would be extended to Eucharistic Prayers II, III, and IV.

Dear OLV Parishioners and friends: A great big THANK YOU goes out to all who donated to the Holy Name of Mary mission. Once again you graciously welcomed Father Ralph for his annual visit. Father Ralph gave us a school update and individual stories of the impact of your generosity to the people in and around the village of Beyin, Ghana and in particular to the children of Holy Name of Mary school. As Father explained in addition to the normal cost of running the school, there are maintenance repairs amounting to approximately \$30,000. This seemed an insurmountable sum but from the generous hearts of parishioners, friends and other churches this goal was achieved.

The parishes of Altoona-Johnstown tend to always go over and above in extending a helping hand and especially here at Our Lady of Victory. The Knights of Columbus raised \$4,141.00 through their annual breakfast for Father Ralph, (Breakfast /\$1,391.00, Donations at the door/\$2,440.00 plus cost of food donated/\$310.41 = \$4,141.41) Added to this the donations received in the collection baskets and individual donations received throughout the summer the final total = \$61,607.00 as of this writing. Your generosity has come to the aid of many the neediest in the world. May God continue to bless all of you with the same kindness and love you have shown to His children.
