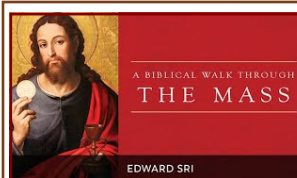


Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Issele-Uku, Nigeria:

My name is Father Callistus Elue, and I am currently the Administrator of SS Gregory & Barnabas Parish, in Johnstown, PA. On behalf of my home Diocese of Issele-Uku, located in Delta State, Nigeria, West Africa, I will speak at all your Masses the weekend of September 21 & 22.

OUR NEEDS AND MISSION CO-OP PRIORITY. Our Diocese currently has 115 parishes, 253 Priests, 107 Nuns, and 83 Major Seminarians serving 884,589 Catholics. The resources and infrastructure required for the work of evangelization are enormous. Funding our Diocesan Emmaus School of Evangelization and our Junior Seminary are the sole responsibility of our Diocese. Our priority for this Appeal is our Seminarians; the cost of training future priests continues to rise. The Diocese does not want to turn away those who have genuine vocations for lack of funds. Poverty, unemployment, and hunger are widespread. Security is also an issue as the incidence of kidnapping and violence against Catholic priests and laypeople is on the rise by terrorist organizations. Most people survive on petty trading and subsistence farming, yet remain resilient and contribute as generously as they are able in cash, time, and talent. The Seminarians themselves engage in manual work normally outsourced, such as housekeeping, farming, maintenance, secretarial duties, and so on, in order to subsidize costs.

Please prayerfully consider donating to support this effort and keep Nigeria in your prayers. Anything you feel called to give will be deeply appreciated. On behalf of my Diocese, thank you, and God bless you for your generosity.

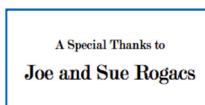
