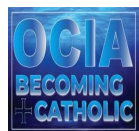

We beg your powerful assistance also for our own personal needs. [In silence mention personal intentions].

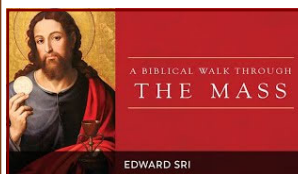
