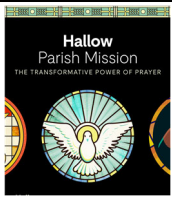


Congratulations to this year's college and high school graduates!

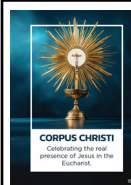
