The Silver Rose is on a pilgrimage around the US, Canada and Mexico in support of the Sanctity and Dignity of all Human life. The program began in 1960. "The Silver Rose was actually a dedication to St. Juan Diego and his meeting with Our Lady and the Miracle of the Roses, when he went back to the bishop and was told to tell him to build a church on the site," said Robert Julian, the Knights' state rose chairman. They were skeptical and told him to bring a sign, Julian said. The Blessed Mother told him to go to the top of the mountain and pick roses that were out of season. "He put the roses in his tunic and dropped it by the governor and Our Lady's image was emblazoned on his cloak and is still visible today." As you see the Silver Rose in the Sanctuary, please pray the Rosary for the Sanctity and Dignity of Life.

Religious Education News

- **CCD and Sacramental Prep registrations are still open** on the Religious Education website. If you are registering for CCD for grades K-8, please use the K-8 registration link. If you are planning on receiving Confirmation next year, please use the appropriate link (CCD or St. Joe's) on the site as well. For families that are new to the parish or are enrolling in CCD for the first time, you will also be prompted to fill in your Family Profile in Flocknote.

- CCD is Sunday, 10:30am to 11:20am starting **September 13, 2026**. Families are asked to attend the 9:30am Mass on 9/13/26 and then remain in the church for a short opening presentation. This is for all families K-9.

- **Volunteers needed:** 2 CCD catechists are needed for elementary grades for the 2026-2027 school year. We also need high school or adult catechist aides. Please contact Susan Ishmael at directorccd@ourladyofvictory.com if you are interested. Youth Protection clearances are required for adults and CCD starts mid-September.

- There will be a **Confirmation parent meeting during CCD class on Sunday, September 20th** in the school gym. This is a meeting meant primarily for parents of CCD students, as we will be going over the Theology of the Body curriculum that will be presented in CCD during the Fall Semester. Other general requirements will also be covered.

- **Summer "To-do" list for students preparing to receive Confirmation on Monday, May 10th, 2027:**

- Confirmation through OLV Religious Ed is for students in 9th-12th grade.
- **Register** for Confirmation on the OLV Religious Ed site (see above), selecting either CCD (signs you up for Sunday AM classes and Confirmation) OR St. Joe's (signs you up for Confirmation; instruction is received at SJCA).
- **Select a sponsor.** This person must be in good standing with the Church and should be a good Christian witness and someone with whom you can talk to about the faith (a sponsor is not a parent, however).
- **Mark your calendar** for one of the 2 required Discipleship Events: **One event for all students will be Adoration with Bishop Mark on Saturday, October 24th @ 10:00am at OLV.** You will receive a list in the fall with other options for the second Discipleship Event.
- **Service hours:** look for and complete 10 service hours between now and next May.
